As you can see there are many places in the centre of the Opole, where you can eat.

- 1. If you are not afraid of self-service you definitely ought to try with your friend (friend will look for the table, when you will be in a que) French pancakes in Grabówka. Low price and the pancake prepared just before you. You can pick something from the menu (https://www.grabowkanalesniki.pl/menu/) or compose your own pancake with available ingredients (the best composititions can be added to the menu of the restaurant). To the pancake I would suggest a salad and 'Kubuś' (dense carrot-fruit juice) :-).
- 2. If you are interested in local, Silesian quisine you can try "Biesiada Opolska" (https://biesiadaopolska.pl/menu/).
- 3. If you are afraid of local cuisine and are looking for something cheaper you can go to level 2 of the 'Solaris' shoping centre where you can find e.g. franchise restaurant as McDonalds (http://www.solariscenter.pl/sklepy/artykuly-spozywcze-strefa-smaku/mcdonalds,106), KFC or 'DekaSmak' (Polish franchise where the price per 100g is fixed and you decide what you want to eat).
- 4. 'Radiowa' restaurant offers interesting cuisine, with names of the dishes associated with radio journalism (http://www.radiowa.opole.pl/index.html). Usually not crowded, quiet place. Also interesting choice of Polish beer.
